

SHIRE OF YORK RESIDENCY MUSEUM Emergency Evacuation Procedure

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, SUCH AS FIRE, EARTHQUAKE, STORM AND/OR OTHER EMERGENCY SITUATION *PLEASE* TAKE NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING EVACUATION PROCEDURE.

- ❖ THE ATTACHED MAP INDICATES EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY AREAS, which are the LAWN and CAR PARK. The person in charge of the evacuation will decide which area is the safest to use.
- ❖ THE CURATOR/VOLUNTEER ON DUTY WILL INITIATE THE EVACUATION OF THE MUSEUM.
- ❖ AS THERE IS NO EVACUATION ALARM SYSTEM INSTALLED IN THIS BUILDING – THE EVACUATION ORDER WILL BE THREE BLASTS ON WHISTLE AND VERBAL AND YOU WILL BE DIRECTED TO EXIT DOORS.
- ❖ Search and Rescue will ONLY be carried out by the relevant emergency authority. (In most instances FESA)
- The person in charge is to designate people to guard entrances to ensure no-one re-enters the building.
- ❖ The "ALL CLEAR" will only be given by the person in charge of the emergency response authority.
