Heritage and History

York is the oldest inland European settlement in Western Australia, situated on the Avon River on Ballardong Noongar land.

After thousands of years of occupation by Ballardong Noongar people, the area was first settled by Europeans in 1831, a town established in 1835 and the first buildings erected in 1836.

The region was important throughout the 19th century for sheep and grain farming and was renowned for its sandalwood trade. York boomed during the gold rush as the last rail stop before the walk to the goldfields.

York continues to attract visitors to its heritage buildings, annual festivals and natural environment.

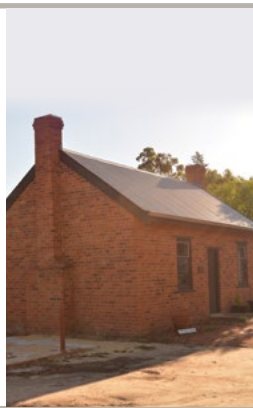


SANDALWOOD YARDS 22/23

SUSPENSION BRIDGE 28 AVON PARK

York's original suspension footbridge first opened in 1888 after petitioning from residents for a footbridge to link pedestrian access east and west. A flood in 1891 saw the river flowing a metre above the foot-walk, but the bridge survived. The bridge was flooded again in 1893, widened and repaired in 1894 and further lengthened and moved to its current position in 1896. The bridge now stands as a testament to times past and continues to attracts visitors to view its unique structure and photo opportunities.

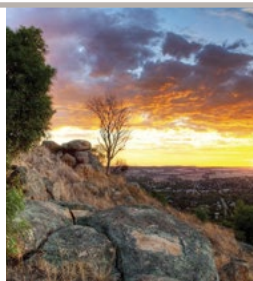

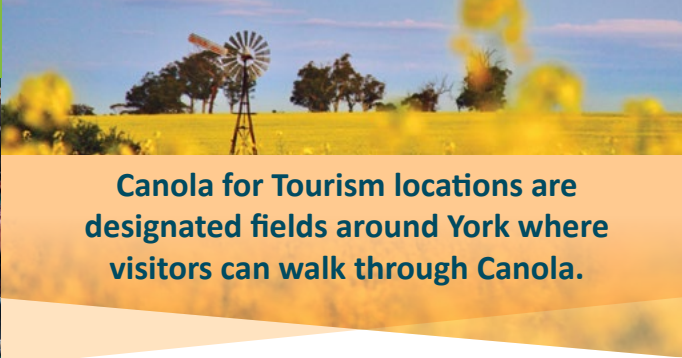


York events celebrate the towns cultural and heritage charm and are full of festive fun for all ages. Events run throughout the year.

Park vehicles safely



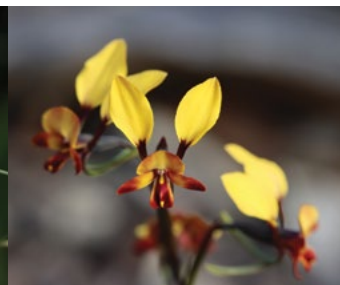

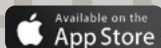
