STREET GREENING PILOT PROGRAM 2024

Guidelines for residents applying for a verge tree.

Description

The Shire of York Strategic Community Plan identifies the following **Priority** under **Goal 4 – Built for Lifestyle and Resilience**

Priority 4.2 – 'Enhance Streetscapes with a focus on trees'

In response to this priority the Shire of York is running a pilot program with the objective to increase the number of street trees in the townsite with a focus on native species from the Wheatbelt.

Expressions of Interest are invited from community members who want to plant a tree on their front verge.

Where the support comes from

This work is funded through the Shire of York municipal budget. It is pilot program to gauge interest and test the project design.

Eligibility Requirements

Applications can be made for a specific property within the York townsite.

Eligible properties are zoned Residential and are around 2000m² or less in area.

What will be provided

One native verge tree can be provided on a 'first in' basis.

Instructions and information will be provided to assist in maximising survival rate and guide planting location.

Who can apply

The property owner or the tenant, with the landholders permission.

Things to consider

One tree can be supplied to a property;

- There are four Wheatbelt species available this year. Each allocation will be made randomly;
- The applicant is responsible for checking the location of underground services and powerlines;
- The applicant will be responsible for preparing the site, including digging the hole, and planting the tree; If the application requires assistance to plant their tree, this can be requested by adding a comment to
- the Expression of Interest Form; The applicant is expected to water and care for the tree throughout at least the first summer; Trees will be available for pick up in July and will require planting within one week of pick up in
- Trees will be available for pick up in July and will require planting within one week of pick up; and Successful applicants will be required to provide a photo update in March 2025.
