PROPOSED PATH NETWORK IMPROVEMENTS VARIATION

The construction of these paths will allow gaps in the current path infrastructure to be completed.

Clifford Street:

The path on Clifford Street is well utilised by the community as it links Balladong Street to Glebe Street, and provides a link for residents connecting the Residency Museum and the Croquet club. Currently there is a gravel path in place which tends to rut and be generally unsuitable for travel during the winter.



Macartney Street:

The Path on Macartney Street is currently incomplete, but provides a link to the path network on Ulster Road which heads towards the swimming pool and the YRCC. This path currently ends at the Pioneer lodge, but users which utilise this path often head towards Ulster Road. Completion of this path will complete the path network between the CBD and Ulster Road.
