### Describe your project and how you are planning to do it (max 250 words)

The Shire of York's - Volunteer grant will provide a formalised morning tea to show thanks and appreciation to approx. 30+ Volunteers who continually contribute time and energy to a number of Shire supported projects.

In previous years, the Shire has recognised individual volunteers who have gone above and beyond the duties of a volunteer by way of special mention in news articles, in speeches or as part of other events largely run through Volunteer support. This year the Shire have a number of Volunteers who have indicated their retirement from volunteering is imminent and would like to take the opportunity the NVW grants offers to formally recognise their efforts and celebrate the continued support our existing volunteer base through a community morning tea.

The morning tea will be served high tea style in the iconic town hall by voluntary support of Community members, new residents and organisations who have had an association with the Shires volunteers through their extensive involvement in projects such as The Welcome to York Bags, Storytime, Library Services, Event support and the development of the 13 self drive tours available through the York Visitors Centre.

Formal presentations by the Shire President and Members of the Community presenting bunches of flowers for each volunteer along with a small memento acknowledging their contribution to Shire services and the Community.

Through consultation with Volunteers it is anticipated approx. 35 - 40 Volunteers of the Shire will be attending the event.

### What are the projects' expected benefits for your community? (max 150 words)

When planning the event, Officers of the Shire asked Volunteers how they envisioned a volunteer event could look. The majority response indicated they would be happy with any event that did not involve them doing the dishes afterwards! Further to this community consultation with groups who had received assistance through the Shire's volunteers on the topic was undertaken and with the volunteers in mind, the concept of a high tea morning tea was developed

The event concept has attracted local attention and inspired collaborative involvement from the York Society, York Community Radio and Friends of the Cemetary to assist in catering and waiting tables for the event. Recognition certificates and small mementos will also be sourced locally with the assistance of the York Men's Shed and the York Community Matters has indicated their intention to run an editorial piece in the newspaper that acknowledges the contribution of all the Shire of York's Volunteers.

The Residency Museums - Thank You For Volunteering Day Out will enable the York Residency Museum to say thank you to our dedicated Volunteers who give their time and energy to our organisation.
