KEY POINTS OF RV PARKING SUBMISSION

YORK MOTOR MUSEUM

Plan to retain only 4-6 sites at the current location.

Reasons for:

- 1. Already infrastructure in place with no extra costs to establish.
- Free security, overnight surveillance of playground, toilet block and park.
 I have heard vandalism repair cost have reduced from around \$40,000 to about \$6,000 per year since RV camping established.
- 3. This location will maintain York's top destination for free camping in WA. Extremely important as the huge web of travellers compare and chat to others as they come and go Australia wide. Please have a look at "wikicamps" app, and see what positive vibes we give out from general comments on York. (unfortunately you will also see the negative comments on the local caravan park)
- 4. Close and safe for travellers to utilise restaurants and hotels at night.

Provide and overflow to the eastern side of river near croquet courts.

Reasons for;

- 1. Reduce vandalism at the croquet club.
- 2. Utilise and financially allow for the beautification of this area.
- 3. Likely to be able to share toilet facilities, or add on before construction of the new croquet clubhouse begins.
- 4. Maybe only minimal lighting required as envisaged no power points need to be available.
- 5. Still a very close walking to town location.
- 6. Allow for many more caravans and motor homes to come and enjoy York and support local businesses.

FINANCIAL POSSIBILITIES AND PROPOSAL.

In many smaller overseas towns they allow limited overnight stays, by permitting local businesses to allocate and sell parking vouchers (to campervans to park in and enjoy spending money in their towns.) This removes the onus on the local authorities to manage, book keep and audit the process.

Our proposal is to sell tickets or overnight vouchers in the museum, as we are open 9am to 4pm daily, and in return we could help manage the camping areas, help fund toilet cleaning and be able spend some money beautifying the eastern area.

The York Motor Museum is the trading name of the Avon Motor Museum Association. This is a community owned and managed venture to primarily keep the museum in York, financially independent, and able to support the growth of this town. The AVMMA is registered as a non for profit charity and all proceeds will be to improve both the museum and in promoting the vitality and vigour of the towns businesses.

Future

There has been studies by the caravan industry in the Eastern States and there is an estimated 500,000 people "on the road" in Australia at any one time. Now many are heading West.

It has been suggested that we need a sign on the Great Eastern Highway coming into Tammin showing an alternative route to Perth via "The oldest inland town and the most historic". (I think the distance to Perth is only 5 kilometres longer) Maybe out York Motor Museum could be incorporated in the signage.

Re: RV PARKING RELOCATION OPTIONS

In conjunction with the Avon Park Redevelopment Plan, the Shire is now seeking 'community feedback' on a proposed relocation of RV parking either to a Monger Reserve site or to an Avon Park / Croquet Club site (as depicted on your recent sketch plans).

My residential property at 22 Monger St, York, overlooks and is directly affected by the former site. You will recall from my email of 10/10/17 and related exchanges that I am strongly opposed to any RV hardstand parking area on or relocated to the Monger Reserve site.

I stand by the grounds of objection set out in my earlier email/letter. Put shortly, if finally the Council feels obliged to proceed further, then in my view the Avon Park / Croquet Club option clearly seems to have greater merit.

The points I wish to make are as follows:

First, the Monger Reserve site is larger (24 RVs), more expensive (\$30,000) more disruptive (parking/traffic adjustments necessary to Thorn/Stephen Streets and on the reserve itself), and will directly affect a number of nearby residents including my own household.

Second, the Avon Park / Croquet Club site is smaller and more manageable (15 RVs), less expensive (\$15,000), does not directly affect nearby residents and is not only favoured by the adjoining Croquet Club but also is closer to the town business centre and related facilities.

Third, responses received by the Shire seem to establish that the somewhat remote or 'out of the way' location of the Monger Reserve site will not be acceptable either to RV visitors to York or to local business owners. This means that in practical terms relocation to the Monger Reserve site will be to no avail and thus a waste of money.

Fourth, the basic objection voiced in my earlier 10/10/17 email letter still remains - even a short stay RV hardstand area will have the look of a permanent caravan park. This will be contrary to the purpose of a public reserve created principally for the recreation of local ratepayers and, by reducing the amenity of a quiet riverfront area adjacent to the central park, will be quite contrary to the spirit of the Avon Park Development Plan.

It follows from the above that in making these submissions that I do not necessarily concede that a proposed relocation to the Monger Reserve site would be lawful, notwithstanding the informal advice that the Shire has apparently received form certain officers of the Lands department.

I trust that a copy of this email letter will be brought before the Council as part of the community feedback and that the community will continue to be kept fully informed as the matter proceeds.


I for one think it is a retrograde step, especially for the town of York and its businesses who as everyone knows, if RVers stop in a town, they invariably spend money on something.

We note that the notice calling for submissions on the relocation of the RV site on the Shire of York website has given two options,

- Monger Reserve located adjacent to the coffee carriage area, and
- Avon Park adjacent to the Croquet Club

It would appear from this that the submission from the York Croquet Club has been considered, but the submission with signatories from the York Business Association – to keep the RV site where it is - has not been offered as an option.

In our opinion, the option is not WHETHER to move the RV site. It is

- 1. to KEEP it where it is, with the commensurate benefits, or
- 2. to LOSE the majority of the RV visitors (and their \$\$ spend).

Verbal feedback, comments left at the York VC and on forums, underline that the RV community appreciate the clean, green and convenience at the existing site AND the amenities and surrounds that we offer. It is highly unlikely that offering an alternative site, without the proximity to shops and businesses that currently exist, would result in the same numbers visiting. From discussion, power is NOT a big draw and they would be happy to be without it, but in the same place.

We wish to advise Council, in the strongest possible terms, that moving the RV site from its current position will most certainly result in loss of business along Avon Terrace, business that comes into the town on a regular basis, 52 weeks of the year, not just during Festival and event times. The RV community operate a highly effective communication system through many websites, forums, Facebook pages etc, and once word was spread that our

central town site has been closed, they will move onto other towns which DO offer that convenience. York has a wonderful name within the caravan community - it would be a pity to lose such a hard won reputation.

This is not even to touch on the savings due to the drop in vandalism since the site has been located in its present position.

As the for spurious implication by stealth of pedophilic caravanners, this is such an ignorant statement, without proof and in contradiction of data showing most abuse being carried out in institutional and/or family situations, it does not warrant further comment.
