GREENHILLS HISTORY TRAIL

Thank you for meeting with us on the 19th February 2018 and for your constructive input regarding our proposed Greenhills History Trail.

The Greenhills Progress Association has been working on a Greenhills History Trail for some time now and we feel to progress the trail further we require the following to be recognised and supported by the Shire Council.

We plan to implement the History Trail over stages, depending on any extra funding we are to receive. We intend on completing the History Trail over 3 stages and require the following support and information from the Shire of York to help us apply for the grants required to get stage one underway.

1. A letter from the Shire of York giving its full support to the Greenhills Progress Association in their endeavours to implement the Greenhills History Trail.
2. Availability of shire services, such as planning and infrastructure people and surveying equipment including maps, to be able to meet the requirements of a Lotterywest application.
3. Access to money held in trust, to use as seed money for grant applications and if and when grants are approved, prompt action on payment to the Greenhills Progress Association or on behalf of the Greenhills Progress Association.

A brief outline of what we wish to achieve in stage one:

- Have all researched information edited and formatted into a standard plaque design to be continued throughout the History Trail.
- Erect a covered/landscaped Gazibo area on Greenhills Progress Association land to install the key/map of the history trail plus additional plaques, photos and information.
- Erect plaques on stands containing our researched information in selected locations.

As some of these plaques are located on Shire land we would appreciate the Shire's position on liability insurance and ongoing trail maintenance? I.e. who holds liability insurance involving plaques and if any repairs/cleaning is required who is to cover costs on this?

We would like to present our history trail information to the Council in the March meeting.

We look forward to finalising our project with your positive support.
