

AVON TERRACE- REVIEW OF PARKING TIME RESTRICTION TO CONSIDER EXTENDING TO A 2 HOUR LIMIT.

The Council is seeking your views on two proposals to change the restricted parking in Avon Terrace.

The two proposals are:

1. To extend the restricted parking in Avon Terrace on both sides of the road to the intersection with Christie Retreat.

This proposal is the result of a request from a business owner in the area of the extension.

2. Amend the current time restriction of one hour in Avon Terrace to two hours.

The Council is proposing this amendment as a result of community feedback following recent moves to enforce the one hour restriction. The Council received feedback that the one hour restriction did not provide adequate time for many people to complete business in the CBD.

The Council believes that a two hour maximum would strike a balance between a reasonable time to complete business and the need to keep the car parks turning over to allow easy access to the CBD. It is noted that there is ample parking in the vicinity of the CBD for visits expected to take longer than two hours.

If both proposals are adopted the parking on both sides of Avon Terrace from the intersection with South Street to the intersection with Christie Retreat will be two hours. The ten minute time restricted bays near the post office and the Disability Parking bays will remain unchanged.

NOTE: The restricted zone correctly described above is slightly different to the description published in the "Voice of York" pages in York and Districts Community Matters.
