

Croquet on the Lawn Hands-on activity

This activity involves participants in:

Dressing up in replica hats of the Edwardian period
Designing their own croquet 'course' of hoops
Improving motor and hand-eye co-ordination skills through playing
Understanding the social context in which the game was played,
through studying the showcase and interpretive panel 'In Leisurely Style.'
Understanding that there is a tangible link between the past and the present
through the current York Croquet Club and existing grounds.

This activity is best played in small groups of four to six students.
