## APPLICATION TO KEEP SIX (6) DOGS AT 54 KNOTTS ROAD, YORK

It is a requirement of the Dog Local Law that the maximum number of dogs that can be kept on premises within a town site is two (2) unless an exemption is granted by Council under the provisions of Section 26(3) of the Dog Act 1976.

The Shire of York has received an application from Mr. Nigel Spencer of the abovementioned property to keep six (6) dogs at that location.

Mr. Nigel Spencer of the above address has been keeping the six (6) dogs in question at 54 Knotts Road for some time and has only just realized that he needs to apply for an exemption to keep more than two (2) dogs.

Mr. Spencer operates a mobile display of farmyard animals and trained working dogs which travels to Schools, Agricultural Shows and prisons etc. The display is called 'Incredible Creatures'.

The above mentioned dogs are fully trained, friendly working sheep dogs that are part of the display.

The dogs in question are:

- 1. A male Australian Shepherd
- 2. A male Kelpie
- 3. A female New Zealand Huntaway.
- 4. A female border Collie/Kelpie cross breed
- 5. A male Kelpie
- 6. A female Border Collie

The Shire Ranger has inspected the above property and considers it suitable for the keeping of six (6) dogs however this matter will be referred to Council for final decision once feedback is received from adjoining neighbours.

Mr. Spencer's property of approximately 11.6 acres contains numerous well-constructed dog pens and large suitably enclosed areas to contain the dogs.

As an adjoining neighbour to the property in question we are notifying you of this application.

If you wish to object to the application to keep six (6) dogs at the above mentioned property, please notify the Shire of York within 10 days of the date of this correspondence.

If no correspondence is received from you within this period, it will be taken that you have no objection to the keeping of the extra dog.
