

Dear Mr Martin

The York Pony Club has been in discussions with your Officers, Ms Natasha Brennan and Ms Esmeralda Harmer regarding the renewal of the lease of the Pony Club Grounds to the York Pony Club, which has been ongoing for some time following our request to renew our existing lease submitted earlier this year.

We continue to be deeply concerned regarding the establishment and ongoing costs of the new lease and have expressed our concerns in our meetings.

The York Pony Club was established in 1964 and for a small Club of just 6 families, we have a long history of riders competing at State level. Pony Club is a youth movement and we provide a safe environment for children and youth to ride and learn horsemanship skills. Our cross country course is one of the best in the State for the size and challenging terrain with many riders travelling to compete from all over the State.

Throughout the year, parents and riders fundraise by holding cake stalls, raffles and events to provide coaching and to improve the equipment and safety of our riders and competitors.

The new proposed lease will cause our small Club to suffer financially due to the significant additional costs of establishing the lease, which we have been informed will be approximately \$1,000 in legal fees and transfer of costs associated with the maintenance of the grounds, which we estimate to be \$3,975 annually based on the Shire rates of \$265 per hour x 15 hours.

As part of our previous lease agreement, the Shire has provided ongoing support to our Club by slashing our cross country area and maintaining our fire breaks on an annual basis, which has been a grateful and significant contribution.

We estimate our Club will have to find approximately \$4,975 annually to service this new lease. How can we ask our members to fundraise just to pay for the lease and to explain that we can no longer afford coaches and new safe equipment?

At our most recent meeting with your Officers, it was suggested that we could apply for funding to cover the costs associated with the lease, including the legal fees, lodgement costs and maintenance of the grounds.

Accordingly, we hereby submit a formal application for multi-year funding for a total annual amount of \$4,175 (\$200 per year for the legal costs over 5 years and \$3,975 per year for grounds maintenance) to will cover the additional costs we will directly incur as a result of the new lease.
