LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROPERTY AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2014

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and by all other powers enabling it, the Council of the Shire of York resolved on 17 February 2014 to make the following local law.

1. Citation

This local law is cited as the Shire of York Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2014.

2. Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the date of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3. Principal Local Law

In this Local Law, the *Shire of York Local Government Property Local Law* published in the *Government Gazette* on 17 January 2001 is referred to as the principal Local Law. The principal local law is amended.

4. Schedule 2 Part 2 Clause 2.3(3) deleted

Delete clause 2.3(3).

Schedule 2 Part 2 Clause 2.4 amended

Delete clause 2.4 and insert-

A person, must not, on local government property deposit or discard refuse, rubbish or liquid waste, except in a place or receptacle set aside by the local government for that purpose and subject to any conditions that may be specified on the receptacle or a sign in relation to the type of waste that may be deposited or other conditions.
