Certification of Building in Dangerous State

On Thursday the 9th of June 2011 at 9.am I inspected the dwelling and property located on lot 39, H/N 208 Avon Terrace, York.

During the inspection I noted the following defects within the brick walled metal roofed house:

- 1. The walls contained cracking of a structural nature up to 5.0 mm in width.
- 2. The carport to the Northern end of the building is in a state of collapse.
- 3. The prop located in the sub-floor basement, supporting the flooring timbers above has become dislodged.
- 4. Steel tubing supporting the rear veranda are not structurally adequate.
- 5. The veranda slab contains structural cracking.
- 6. A portion of the roof is missing.
- 7. The roof contains timbers that are not structurally adequate.

Due to the building defects listed I certify that the building is dangerous and not suitable for human habitation.
