Lesser Hall	Can safely and legally accommodate current numbers of patrons	Poor Acoustics, Poor lighting, not permanently set up as a Council meeting venue	96 Persons
Masonic Hall	Can safely and legally accommodate current numbers of patrons.	Venue incurs hire fees. Requires temporary setup and dismantling of meeting furniture. Ambience of venue could be improved. Disabled access and facilities may be a problem.	75 Persons
York CRC	Modern well equipped meeting room. Disabled access and facilities available.	Venue incurs hire fees.	131 persons
York YRCC	Modern well equipped meeting room. Can safely and legally accommodate current numbers of patrons. Disabled access and facilities available	Licenced venue resulting in noise distractions during meetings	272 persons
York Hockey Club	Club Rooms can safely and legally accommodate current numbers of patrons.	Seating and tables require transporting to and from venue. May interfere with hockey club training activities	105 Persons
