Re: APPLICATION FOR FUNDING - YORK BOWLING CLUB (INC)

The York Bowling Club (YBC) hereby requests funding of \$25,000 from the Shire of York for the cost of installation of an automatic watering system for the bowling greens. In order to secure that funding, we would ask the Shire of York to include that amount of \$25,000 in the current application for DSR Small Grants.

The total cost would be in the vicinity of \$25,000 comprising \$16,621 for installation of the watering system (quote attached), \$3,000 for connection of water and electricity and \$5,400 for supply of pump and tanks. All associated site works will be carried out by local business ensuring that the project generates employment within the Shire of York.

As discussed during our meeting 6th May 2014, the YBC through the assistance of volunteers will continue to maintain the greens and surrounds. The installation of the automatic watering system is an integral component of that maintenance programme.

The bowling greens are a valuable asset owned by the shire of York and ongoing maintenance will extend the life of that asset to the direct benefit of the Shire of York and the local community in general. Well presented "greens" will attract players from outside clubs keen to compete in pennant and open day competitions. Both pennant and competitions have a direct benefit to the YRCC in the form of increased bar sales and meals while the open competitions run all weekend and benefit the Town of York in general and in particular the hospitality industry.

I trust that the Shire of York will include our request within the current application for DSR Small Grants.

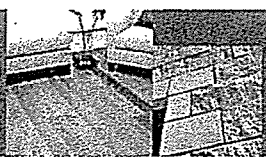

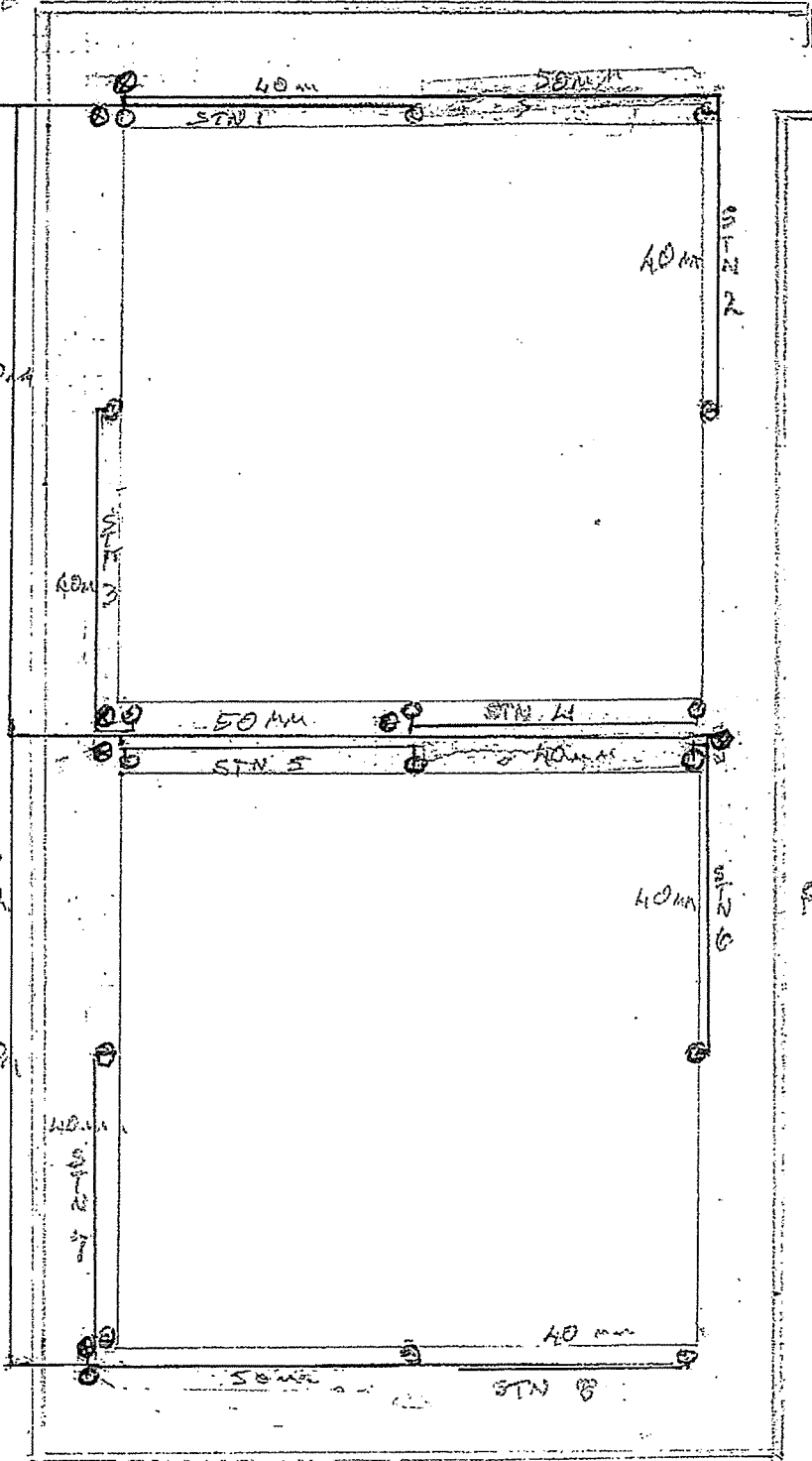

GUIDELINES

- The Council will consider sponsorship applications from community groups and organisations. The request may be for a specific event/project or be a contribution towards continued operations.
- Applications from an individual will not be considered as part of this sponsorship programme.
- For projects valued in excess of \$10,000 Council will only fund up to a maximum of one third of the cash component of the project. (For example a project estimated to cost \$15,000 in total with \$3,000 worth of voluntary labour and \$12,000 in cash expenditure the Shire will only fund up to a maximum of one third of the cash expenditure of \$12,000 – in this case being \$4,000)
- Applicants are expected to have sought funding from other external funding bodies such as Lotterywest, Department of Sport and Recreation and Healthways.
- Only one contribution will be made to any organisation during each financial year (**1 July 2013 to 30 June 2014**).
- The Council will call for sponsorship applications in February/March each year. Successful applicants will be advised after the adoption of the budget by Council.
- Applications must be received by the closing date **Thursday, 28th March 2013**. All applications will be acknowledged, in writing and submitted to the Council for evaluation. If required organisations submitting applications may be asked to provide additional information.
- Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified in writing after the adoption of the budget.
- The Council's decision will be final and no further correspondence about the decision will be entered into with the applicants.
- An acquittal report must be submitted within four weeks of the event or on the completion of the project. **If the project cannot be completed within the financial year, correspondence is to be provided regarding the delays for Council to consider carrying over the approved amount.**

HOW TO APPLY

Applications will be called for once a year through advertisements in the local media. A completed sponsorship application form must accompany all submissions.

All applications must include the following information in order for the Council to consider for sponsorship:

⇒ **Purpose for which the sponsorship will be utilised**

- ◆ The objectives and purpose of the organisation seeking funding.
- ◆ Description of event, project (if applicable).

⇒ **Community Benefit**

- ◆ Demonstration of how sponsorship funding will benefit the community of the Shire of York.

⇒ **Sponsor Benefits**

- ◆ Details of the benefits which will be delivered to the Council of the Shire of York in return for a commitment of sponsorship.

⇒ **Other Sponsorship Funding**

- ◆ Details of support already received or committed from other sponsors for the same purpose.
- ◆ Details of other organisations that you have sought funding from for this project but have not been successful in your application.

⇒ **Sponsorship Value Requested**

- ◆ A monetary value must be specified.

⇒ **Financial Information**

- ◆ A copy of the current budget/financial statements of the organisation.
