It is considered that the amendments to standards (whether these are accepted or not, as the standard of road construction is to be managed as a condition of approval) will not reduce the overall estimated cost of development to less than \$10 million, which is the mandatory threshold requiring a DAP application to be submitted, or \$2 million which is the 'opt-in' dap threshold where the applicant can request that the application be determined by the JDAP. The estimated cost of development is immaterial to the application fee for a form 2/amendment application which is a fixed rate.  Discussion on the application for extension is discussed in the Planning Assessment section within the RAR.
